-10x10 space costs \$40.00. If you need more than one space, it is \$40 each. Vendors are responsible for any taxes collected.

-This event is for horse and dog related items, food vendors, new or used tack/supplies, handcrafted gift items, crafts, western wear, health/wellness products, etc. (Please no garage sale clothing or other used household items other than pet related). We will limit the items so we don't end up with too many of the same type of things. Your registration payment date will determine who gets in if we have too many of one thing.

*-You must supply your own table and chairs. Tents are allowed but not required. Tables must be **COVERED** with a tablecloth. Please understand that you will be set up either in one of the barns or outside. It can be windy up here on the hill so plan your displays and tents accordingly. (sand bags or whatever)*

-No rain dates. *If bad weather, we will set up throughout barns.*

-Food vendors must abide by local Board of Health regulations and obtain necessary permits prior to the event. If we have multiple food vendors, only one per type of food will be accepted. (ex. One BBQ, one coffee/drinks, one Mexican food...)

*-Vendors are asked to provide **LOGOS (at minimum) and PRODUCT/SERVICE PHOTOS WITH APPLICATION.** This will help in our promotion of the event. Please send these in with application if possible. The sooner we get them, the sooner we can start promoting you.*

-Vendors must stop selling at 4:00 pm. Gates will be closed and locked for the night. You can choose to cover your items for the night or pick up and put back out the following day. Although we can help secure items, we will not have guards on duty.

SEMINARS will run throughout the day starting at 10am. Schedule will be posted for those participating in this option once we have reached the February 28th application deadline. We want to set this schedule early so we can let visitors know what times you will be presenting. The back barn has a great space for seminars. It should be pretty quiet back there. We will have chairs set up for attendees and a table with a cloth on to use if you need one. These seminars can be informational about your products with time for questions/answers. If you provide a therapy, you could use an actual horse, dog or human (or whatever) to introduce your therapy and provide attendees with knowledge about the therapy in general or about more specific issues they may come across. It is up to you what you present obviously but our vision is to inform animal loving attendees of ways they can keep their pets healthy and happy. The ideas are endless!
